Park Walkabout

FoCVP committee members met with Paul and Grant, Calderdale Park staff for our periodic walkabout every 4 months. We share concerns and get updates on work being done in the park.

Calderdale council is still struggling to fund maintenance and improvements, and has been short



of staff, but there is good news - it is recruiting 10 park and recreation staff, 5 gardeners and 5 on the cleansing side across the borough. We hope this will help to speed up getting things done.

Green Sports Centre: We visited the site of the air source heat pump at the back of the Sports Centre, now complete along with the installation of the solar panels. It has been newly landscaped with trees planted and wild flowers sown, and there is a plan to sow more wild flowers in due course.

Green Flag Status

The flag pole is not yet up for the green flag that should fly over the park to mark its Green Flag status. We were told by park staff it will be in place by the end of June-but we are still waiting.

We hope for continuing Green Flag status – it was granted last summer - the park will receive an unannounced visit sometime in the near future to see if the status is to continue.
