




Litter Pickers!

A leisurely two hour stroll, led by local birders Bob Still and Steve Blacksmith, within the woods and parkland - bring binoculars and a flask (24 places max).



Construction and Demolition

The park will be looking like a building site for a few months yet. The entry road, drainage and grounds for the temporary school are well underway - the temporary classrooms arrive end of May, and the children from September. The demolition and rebuilding of the Bowling Pavilion is planned to start on 24 April - the start of the restoration of the Bandstand on the same day. The demolition of the Conservatory in the Remembrance Gardens is due to commence before the end of April. Lastly, the entrance barrier is to be replaced with entry poles to improve public accessibility.
